FUEL CONSERVATION MEASURES ANNOUNCED BY THE GOVERNMENT

The Government has announced that the conflict in the Middle East could create a fuel shortage in the country and made a request to reduce the fuel consumption to mitigate the impact.

In addition to the fuel quota restrictions introduced through the QR Code System, the Government has declared Wednesdays as a weekly holiday for public sector employees and requested the private sector to take appropriate measures to address the situation.

We are mindful of the essential services carried out by the private sector in the health, aviation, port, logistics, agriculture, financial and other similar sectors that require uninterrupted services for continuity of operations.

While due consideration should be given to essential operations, we encourage member companies to scale down non-essential activities and as appropriate implement work from home in order to reduce the impact of fuel consumption during this period.

We also encourage members to take all such measures required that will contribute to fuel conservation including introduction of a short working week where possible and based on requirements of each organization.
